


## Field visit report

**The consequences of flood situation in Dubasari, Criuleni, Ocnita and Briceni, as of July 30, 2008.**

**The information has been obtained through observations in the field and from rayon and local authorities.**

<p><b>Rayon Dubasari</b></p> <p><b>Contact people:</b> <b>Mr. Iurii Cazacu -</b> <b>Director of Rayon</b> <b>Emergency Depart;</b></p> <p><b>Mayors of the</b> <b>villages: Dorotscaia,</b> <b>Pirita, Cosnita</b></p>	<p>By July 30, 2008, there are no substantial inundations and serious damages produced in the localities of rayon Dubasari.</p> <p>However, five localities are at risk: <u><i>Ustia, Dorotscaia, Pohrebea, Pirita and Cosnita.</i></u></p> <p>By the end of July 30, there are no buildings, households or public facilities inundated in the mentioned above villages.</p> <p>Only in the village Ustia 8ha of people small agricultural lands have been inundated.</p> <p>People were not evacuated. No victims.</p> <p>In case if water level in Dnister river will increase there is a risk that about 200ha of agricultural lands will be inundated in Dorotscaia.</p> <p>Rayon and LPA take all necessary measures to protect villages and lands from the flood.</p> <p><b>Pohrebea</b></p> <div data-bbox="507 1462 1193 1713"></div> <p><b>Dorotscaia</b></p>

At present there is no need for urgent or long term assistance from donor agencies in Dubasari, related to actual flood situation.

By July 30, 2008, there are no substantial inundations and serious damages produced in the localities of rayon Criuleni..

However, there are two villages at risk to be inundated: Cosernita and Dubasarii Vechi.



In these two villages, by July 29, 2008, there are no flooded buildings, households or public facilities.

Only in Cosernita 6 kitchen gardens have been inundated by the time of visit and approximately 10ha of small farmers' agricultural lands have been inundated in Dubasarii Vechi.

Additionally to that, 120 small lands, villas, situated near to village Balabanesti, that commonly belong to people from Chisinau, have been inundated too.

People were not evacuated.  
No victims.

In case if water level in Dnister river will increase with 25-30cm, there is a risk that about 10 households in Cosernita and about 6 -8 households in Dubasarii Vechi will be inundated.

<p><b>Rayon Ocnita</b></p> <p><b>Contact people:</b>  <b>Topa Andrei –</b>  <b>Vice president of</b>  <b>Rayon Council;</b></p> <p><b>Mayor of the</b>  <b>village Valcinet</b></p>	<p>By July 30, 2008 five localities have been affected by flood of Dnister river in Ocnita: <i>Valcinet, Otaci, Calarasauca, Unguri, and Naslavcea.</i></p> <p>1. In total 37 households in four localities have been inundated:  Valcinet -20,  Otaci - 7,  Calarasauca -7,  Unguri -3 and  .</p> <p>2. 168 people have been affected and evacuated from their houses. People have been evacuated to their relatives. Evacuated people are provided three times a day with food and water by Rayon and LPA. Only 40 - 45 people come every day to the café “Alexandra” for breakfast, lunch and dinner. There is enough food and water for them.</p>

3. 1400 of people were temporary disconnected from electricity, 322 - from gas until flood water got back.

4. 150 shallow wells in three villages were inundated and need to be cleaned and disinfected. There is enough disinfection material in place and brigades of people are ready to start the work.

5. 2 artesian wells are still inundated by flood in town Otaci and about 1000 people are provided with potable water transported by trucks. There is a need to investigate the state of artesian wells, test quality of water and connect to electricity.

6. In the village Valcinet 4.06ha of small agricultural lands have been inundated.

7. The school from the village Calarasauca has been inundated. Sport hall placed in the basement of school has been fully inundated and roof of kitchen and festive hall block has been seriously deteriorated and actually leaks.

It is not possible to renovate those two facilities by September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 and LPA needs external technical and financial support as to be able to renovate the school in the next half a year or even longer.

No other public facilities affected by flood in the inundated villages from rayon.

Actually river level decreased, there is access to houses and situation in inundated localities got calm.

LPA calculate the dimensions of real damages in the villages. They need about 10 days for completion of reports.

1. As an argent request from authorities it was: (i) provision with mobile pumps to clean wells and houses from water, and (ii) disinfection materials.
2. Rayon and LPA actually are renovating the roads using their own resources.
3. It is necessary to rehabilitate or built new 37 houses for suffered families.

*Proposal for long term assistance:*

*It would be a substantial support for rayon authorities when provide financial assistance for renovation of gymnasium (sport hall in the basement and new roof and internal repair works in the kitchen and festive hall block) in the village Calarasauca where study about 114 children.*

By July 30, 2008 five localities have been affected by flood of Prut river in Briceni: *Criva, Drepcauti, Lipcani, Siriuti, and Balasinesti.*

1. In total 290 households in four localities have been inundated and 691 of people have been affected by flood:

Criva -85, affected people - 167  
 Drepcauti - 142, affected people - 373  
 Lipcani -52, affected people - 116  
 Siriuti -8, affected people - 26  
 Balasinesti – 2, affected people – 6 and  
 Bogdanesti – 1, affected people 3

2. All affected people have been evacuated to their relatives, are in security and are provided with food and water.

3. LPA decided to provide suffered families with new lands (about 0.12 - 0.15 ha per family) in the new protected parts of the villages Criva and Drepcauti for construction of new houses, because all inundated houses can not be used for living any longer.

	<p>There is also an option to buy some existing houses in the villages that are presented for sale.</p> <p>4. In Drepcauti secondary school and families doctors offices seriously suffered from flood.</p> <p>At school there is a need to rehabilitate sport hall: to renovate roof, internal walls and floor.</p> <p>Medical office is about 100 years old, walls are made of clay. It really has to be rebuilt.</p> <p>Roads do not have any serious deterioration.</p> <p>63 shallow wells have been inundated and now should be cleaned and disinfected.</p> <p>Central water supply system did not suffer from flood.</p> <p>About 500ha of agricultural lands have been inundated and more than 70% of agricultural products will be lost.</p> <p>5. In Criva it was inundated the same lowest part of the village that was inundated in 1969. This is second inundation of this part of the village and all the houses will be removed to a new protected part of the village.</p> <p>No public facilities affected by flood in Criva. Local roads did not suffer from the flood too. About 400ha of agricultural lands have been inundated and the yields will be lost by more than 70%.</p> <p>Actual situation the villages is clam.</p> <p>LPA calculate the dimensions of real damages in the villages. They need about 10 days for completion of reports.</p> <p>Criva</p>

#### Medical office



1. There is a need for construction or buying about 290 new houses in new parts of inundated 6 localities from rayon Briceni.

2. It will be also necessary to build new infrastructure: roads (gravel roads), electricity and water supply networks in the villages Criva and Drepcauti.

3. Sport hall building of secondary school in Drepcauti has to be rehabilitated.

4. The Office of Family Doctors in Drepcauti has to be rebuilt.

*Proposal for long term assistance:*

*(i) It would be most effective provide technical and financial*

	<p><i>assistance for rehabilitation of sport hall in the village Drepcauti,</i></p> <p><i>(ii) Building of new office for families' doctors or rehabilitation of another space appropriate for needed medical service in Drepcauti.</i></p> <p><i>(iii) Building of new water supply networks and gravel local road in the villages Criva and Drepcauti where are going to be built new houses.</i></p>
